Double trailer trucks are large trucks pulling two separate 28-foot long trailers that are over 70 feet long. These double trailer trucks are currently allowed on major roads in every state. Congress is now considering a bill that would require all states to allow double trailer trucks to pull two 33-foot trailers, making the truck 10 feet longer, the length of an 8-story building.
