



Updates to 2018 Roadmap of State Highway Safety Laws Report As of June 2018

Enacted:



Idaho: Enacted an all-offender ignition interlock device law.



Iowa: Enacted an all-offender ignition interlock device law.



Nebraska: Upgraded child passenger safety laws by enacting a requirement for children to rear facing through age two and by extending its booster seat law to age eight.



Virginia: Upgraded child passenger safety laws by enacting a requirement for children to remain rear facing through age two.

Illinois: Upgrade to child passenger safety laws to include a requirement for children to remain rear facing through age two.
