As you may have heard, major auto and equipment manufacturing companies, after covering up defects for years, have recalled tens of millions of vehicles as well as airbags for safety defects. Those defects resulted in hundreds of deaths and these companies have paid monetary fines. However, no company officials have been prosecuted because there is no law that makes it a crime to conceal information about deadly safety defects from government regulators or to sell a vehicle with deadly safety defects.
