Idaho: Enacted an all-offender ignition interlock device law.



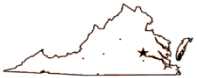
Illinois: Upgraded child passenger safety laws by enacting a requirement for children to remain in rear facing safety seats through age two.



Iowa: Enacted an all-offender ignition interlock device law.



Nebraska: Upgraded child passenger safety laws by enacting a requirement for children to remain in rear facing safety seats through age two and by extending the booster seat law to age eight.



Virginia: Upgraded child passenger safety by enacting a requirement for children to remain in rear facing safety seats through age two.
